Fire Lighting

Location: Generic

Hazard	Potential harm	To Whom	Control Measures
Fire , hot surfaces and objects	Personal injury – burn.	Staff, participants and public	<p>Staff to police the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only wood to be used as fuel, only fire kindling, Jute, paper and cotton wool to be used to light the fire. • Fire to be no bigger than 50cm by 50cm. • Participants to remain seated at all times when within 3 m from the fire. • Container for water (min 2 gallons) or bucket of sand to be on-hand at all times to extinguish the fire if needed. • Participants must not 'poke' or 'stir' the fire. • The fire MUST be fully extinguished before leaving the site and left in a safe state.
Spread of fire	Personal Injury /Death	Staff, participants and public	<p>Staff to monitor:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Area used must be clear of other fuel sources. • Wind force and direction must be monitored by instructor • Adequate provisions for extinguishing fire must be available. (Water/Sand/fire extinguisher)

Risk assessments are to be reviewed on an annual basis unless an incident occurs, which then dictates immediate review of the risk assessment.
